# Proposed Design

## Versatile spaces and inspiring places: a three phase approach:

Our proposal features **two main spaces**: one that enables our teaching staff the space to engage a class in outdoor learning in an inspiring setting; and another that provides for full grade-level sized groups or larger community organizations to gather.

**The Upper Naturescape** would be located nearest the BMS building and contain several picnic tables providing seating for up to 25 people—a place for kids to sit and chat during recess; a great meeting place for a school class or local community group (such as the Boy Scouts or Bow Young at Heart Club); or a lunch spot for a local parent and child group.

**The Lower Naturescape** would showcase an amphitheater built into the hillside overlooking a stage and the baseball field and provide sufficient space and additional seating for an outdoor classroom for grade-level based learning and community events.
